THE WINE PRESS AND THE CELLAR.

The Wine Press and the Cellar, a manual for the wine maker and the cellar man, is the title of a work just published, from the pen of E. H. Rickford.
The work, the author says in the preface, is the result of research by himself, chiefly for his own benefit, and in going over the literature of the subject, the author has failed to find a work in the English language which is adequate to the needs of the practical wine maker.
The book is intended to supply the deficiency.
Embarrassed statistics of the California wine product are given.
Besides the preface, the work contains twenty chapters, each embracing a distinct subject relating to the manufacture of the various wines and putting it up for market; defects of wine, ascertained by means of analysis, etc., with forty-two illustrations.
The process begins with the gathering of the grape, following each step and the processes attending it, in the manufacture; treating of the various qualities, and the cases upon which these various differences depend.
The book contains 250 pages, and is thoroughly indexed.
